- Non-powered craft may use reach if the timetabled users are not there, but must vacate the area should one appear
- All vessels transiting the reach area must use the North shore, passing other craft port to port, giving a wide berth to other reach users.
- Water-ski slots will not be in use November – February inclusive

All vessels must be registered at the Tees Barrage before going onto the water
